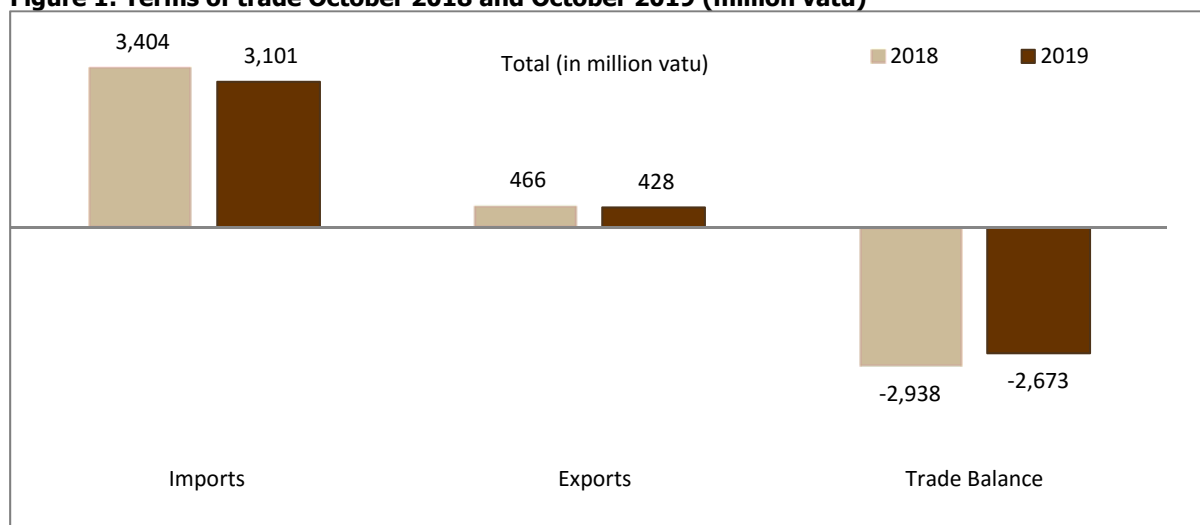


## STATISTICS UPDATE: INTERNATIONAL MERCHANDISE TRADE STATISTICS

### OCTOBER 2019 PROVISIONAL HIGHLIGHTS

RELEASE DATE: 6<sup>th</sup> December 2019

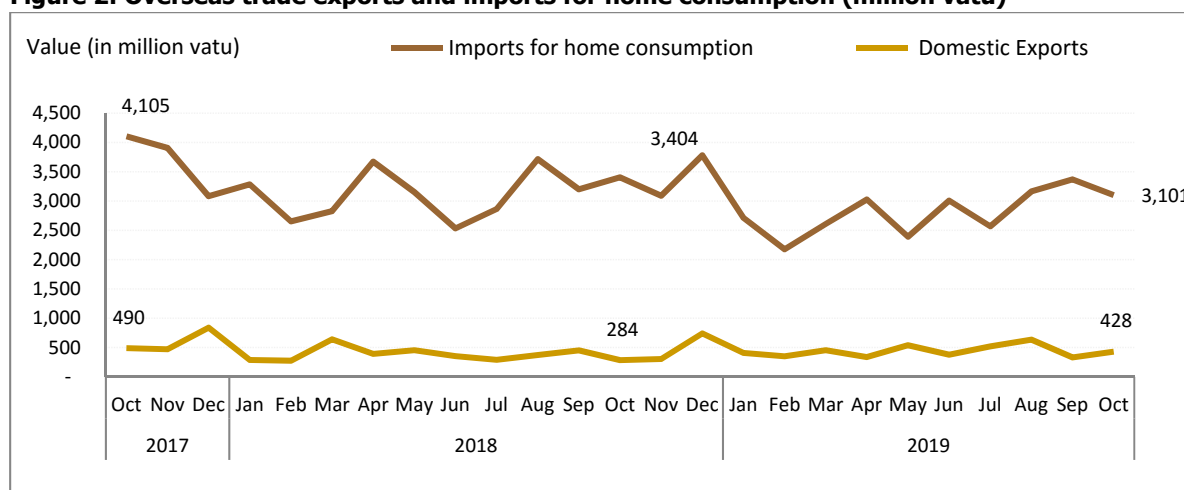
**Figure 1: Terms of trade October 2018 and October 2019 (million vatu)**



Merchandise trade provisional figures for October 2019 showed deficit balance of VT 2,673 million, a decrease in the value of imports VT 3,101 million and exports that of VT 428 million compared to the previous year.

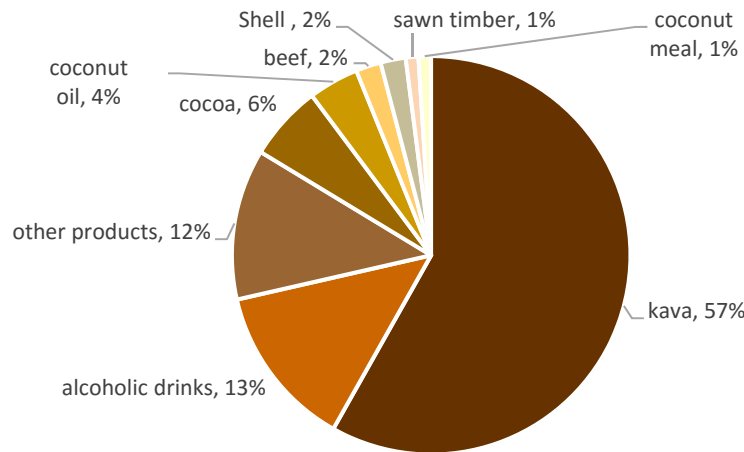
Domestic export earnings (excluding re-exports) increased 51% in October 2019 over October 2018. Export decreases were attributed mainly by copra, coconut oil, sawn timber, vanilla and coffee.

**Figure 2: Overseas trade exports and imports for home consumption (million vatu)**



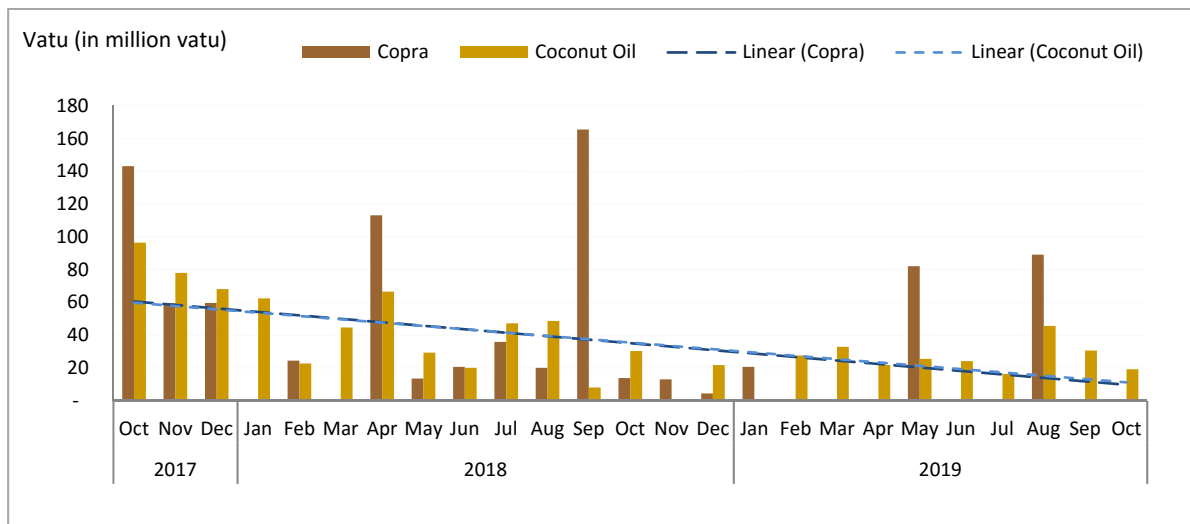

**Figure 3: Share of main domestic products total value**



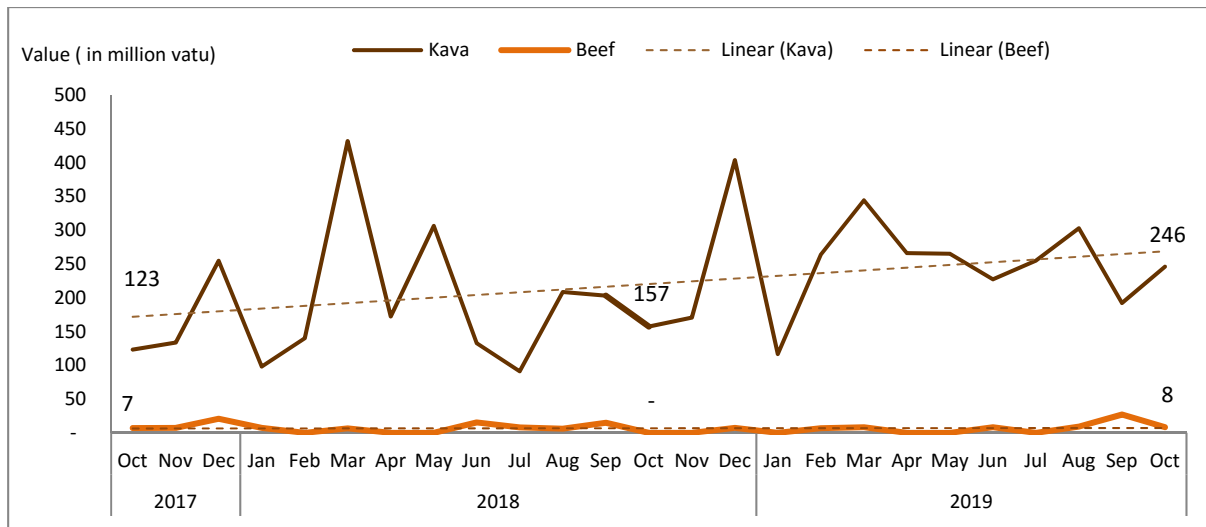
The main shares of domestic products total value in October 2019 were: Kava at 57%, followed by alcoholic drinks at 13%, cocoa at 6%, coconut oil at 4%, beef and shell at 2% each, sawn timber and coconut meal at 1% each, while other products accounts for 12%. Other products consisted of animal products, mineral products, base metals and articles thereof.

Coconut products export total was VT 23 million in October 2019, showing 52% or VT 25 million, decrease in comparison to October 2018. Coconut oil exports was the main contributor in October 2019 at VT 19 million, followed by coconut meal at VT 4 million.

**Figure 5: Exports of Kava and Beef Products (million vatu)**

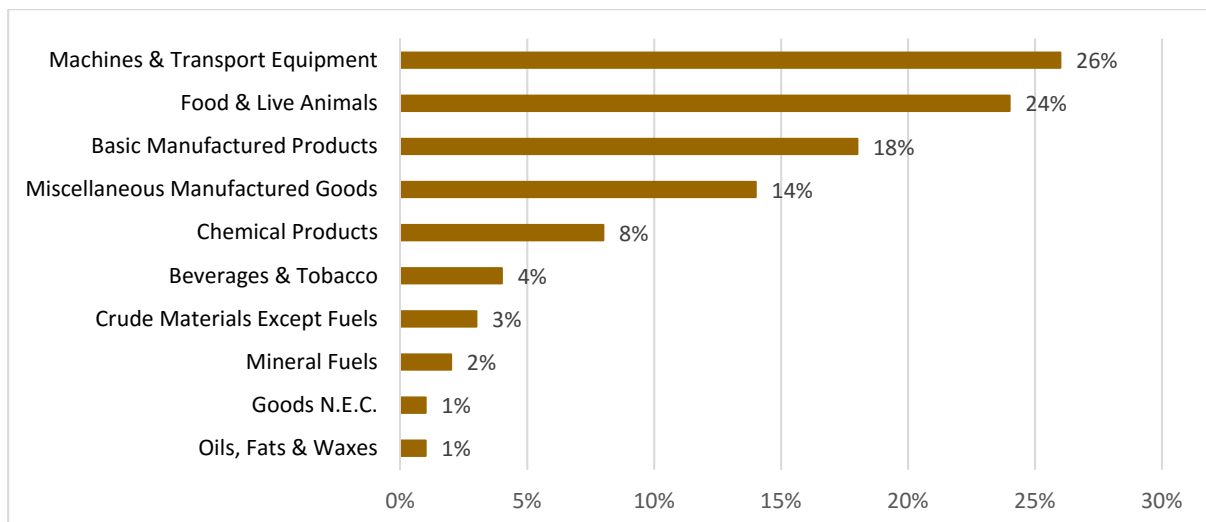


Kava exports in October 2019 stood at VT 246 million, 56% or VT 89 million in value increase in comparison to October 2018. However, beef exports recorded a shipment of VT8 million in October 2019. The country of destinations for kava exports remained unchanged in October 2019 led by Kiribati Fiji, United States of America, New Caledonia, followed closely by China and New Zealand, While beef exports were mainly to Japan.

## IMPORTS

In terms of share of commodity groups to total imports receipts, machines and transport equipment represented the largest value (C.I.F) of VT 796 million or 26% of the total imports for home consumption in October 2019, followed by food and live animals at 24%, basic manufactured products at 18%, miscellaneous manufactured goods at 14%, chemical products at 8%, beverages and tobacco at 4%, crude materials except fuels at 3%, mineral fuels at 2%, goods not classified elsewhere, and oils, fats and waxes at 1% each respectively.

Compared to October 2018, miscellaneous manufactured goods increased at 29% or VT 99 million in October 2019, followed by chemical products at 15% and basic manufactured goods at 10%. Nevertheless, the rest of the commodity groups decreased: mineral fuels at (84%), beverages and tobacco at (39%), crude materials except fuels at (14%), goods not elsewhere classified and food and live animals at (6%) each, oils, fats and waxes at (4%) while machines and transport recorded less than (1%).

## DATA SOURCE AND REVISIONS

The Vanuatu National Statistics Office receives import and export statistics data on quantity and value from the Department of Customs and Inland Revenue's ASYCUDA World merchandise trade processing system.

The Vanuatu National Statistics Office will be releasing Provisional International Merchandise Trade Statistics highlighted in the monthly releases. On occasion, revisions are made to import and export entries after publication. Where revisions are necessary, these are highlighted in the statistical tables. The Vanuatu National Statistics Office makes every possible effort to check the data and resolve inconsistencies and anomalies with the Department of Customs and Inland Revenue prior to publishing of actual figures in Quarterly or annual Statistical Indicator report.

## CONCEPTS AND DEFINITIONS

- **Imports for Home Consumption** are goods, materials or articles purchased in other countries and brought into Vanuatu and cleared through customs procedures for home consumption. Imports for home consumption are valued on a C.I.F. (cost, insurance, freight) basis. This means that for each commodity, the value recorded includes the factory price, the cost of packaging, the freight cost from overseas to Vanuatu ports and the insurance.
- **Exports** are expressed in F.O.B. (free on board) prices. It means the total value includes the production cost and the transport cost to the Vanuatu port of export.
- **Imports for re-export** refers to imports destined to be re-exported without having undergone any transformation, or only minor ones. This is especially the case of duty free goods and fuel "imported" into the country and sold to non-resident airline operators or ships.
- **Re-exports** are goods, materials or articles exported in the same condition as they were imported, and imported goods, which have undergone operations such as repair, repacking, or bottling which leave them essentially unchanged before exporting.
