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VNSO Update Overseas Trade, December 2010

December Highlights

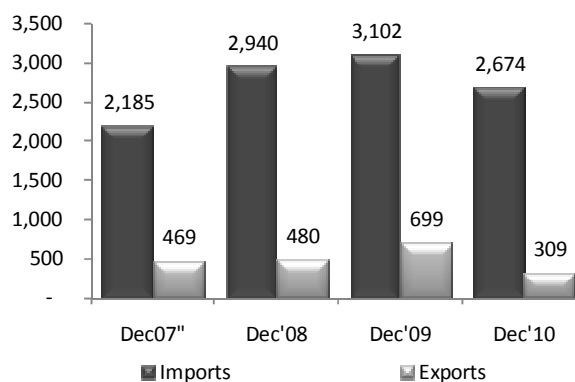
According to the December 2010 provisional trade figures, the trade deficit stood at 2,366 million Vatu indicating an improvement of 37 million Vatu but a deterioration of 228 million Vatu over the same period in 2009 and the previous month.

In December 2010 total imports decreased by 14 per cent to 2,674 million Vatu from 3,102 million Vatu over the same period in 2009. This decrease was due to a decrease of 14 per cent in imports for home consumption to 2,672 million from 3,100 million Vatu over December 2009.

Domestic exports earnings (excluding re-exports)

for December 2010 declined by 46 per cent to 309 million vatu compared to 573 million vatu over the same period in 2009. This decrease was mainly attributable to decreases on commodities such as; Coconut oil (-96%), Beef (-43%), and Cocoa (-12%) during the reference period. However slight increases are recorded in value for kava and live fish exports by 57 per cent and 8 per cent, followed by the rest of the group with increases in value compared to the same period in 2009

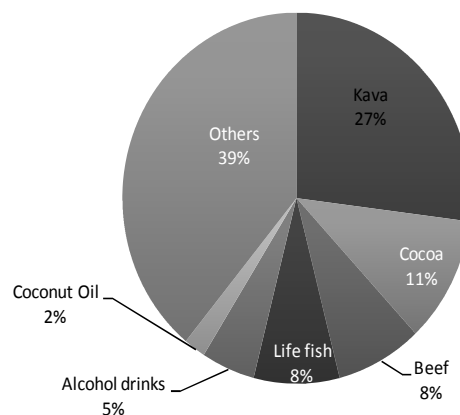
Total Imports and Exports (million vatu)



Key Commodities

In December 2010 Kava constituted 27 per cent of the total domestic exports in Vatu terms, followed by Cocoa 11 per cent, Beef and Life fish 8 per cent each, Alcoholic drink 5 and Coconut oil (2%). Other includes products such as: other frozen chilled fish, sandal wood oil, citrus fruits, personal effects, and medicaments.

In December 2010 Imports, machine and transport and food & live animals had the largest value (C.I.F), contributing 22 per cent each of the total imports for home consumption, followed by Mineral fuels and miscellaneous manufactured goods 12 per cent each, basic manufactured goods and chemical products 11 per cent each, Other commodities such as beverages and tobacco, crude materials and Oils and fats made up less than 10 per cent of the total imports for home consumption.

In December 2010 increases were recorded in imports of oils and fats 96 per cent, crude materials 64 per cent, beverages and tobacco 56 per cent, food and live animals 11 per cent, and while the rest of the imported items recorded a decrease: goods not classified elsewhere (-56%), mineral fuels (-37%), machines and transport (-23%) basic manufactured goods (-21%), miscellaneous manufactured goods (-20%), and chemical products (-13%) when compared to December 2009.

Revisions to imports and exports statistics

The National Statistics Office receives imports and exports statistics data on quantity and value from the Department of Customs and Inland Revenue. On occasion revisions are made to import and export entries after publication by Vanuatu Statistics Office. The Vanuatu Statistics Office makes every possible effort to check the data published and resolved inconsistencies and anomalies with colleagues from the Department of Customs and Inland Revenue.

But sometimes revisions are necessary. This happened in exports of coffee in March 2010, and also for cocoa and kava exports in June 2010 which were revised after publication. These changes can only be highlighted as revised.

Source of Statistics: The Department of Customs and Inland Revenue provide the NSO access to their ASYCUDA merchandise trade processing system to derive the imports and exports statistics included here.

Concepts and definitions

- **Imports for Home Consumption** is goods, materials or articles bought in other countries and brought into Vanuatu and cleared through customs procedures for home consumption. Imports for home consumption are valued on a C.I.F. (cost, insurance, freight) basis. This means that for each commodity, the value recorded includes the factory price, the cost of packaging, the freight cost from overseas to Vanuatu ports and the insurance.
- **Exports** are expressed in F.O.B. (free on board) prices. It means the total value includes the production cost and the transport cost to the Vanuatu port of export.
- **Imports for re-export** refers to imports destined to be re-exported without having undergone any transformation, or only minor ones. This is especially the case of duty free goods and fuel “imported” into the country and sold to non-resident airline operators or ships.
- **Re-exports** are goods, materials or articles exported in the same condition as they were imported, and imported goods, which have undergone operations such as repair, repacking, or bottling which leave them essentially unchanged before exporting.

• *Concepts and definitions for Vanuatu International Merchandise Trade statistics, sourced from the Customs and Inland Revenue Department (CIRD) data system (ASYCUDA), have undergone a major revision as part of the National Accounts Rebasing undertaken in 2009. The definitions for what constitutes an import for home consumption and an export are now consistent with international standards. The data series were reviewed and redeveloped from 1998 to date. There has also been a major improvement in the data exchange system between the CIRD and VNSO which has facilitated the data auditing, and a subsequent improvement in the data consistency checks for the series.*
