OVERVIEW

Cattle Production (refer to Table 1.2)

- The total number of cattle heads slaughtered by abattoirs in June quarter 2016 stood at 3,653 heads, an increase of 15% over June quarter 2015 and 2% over the previous quarter.

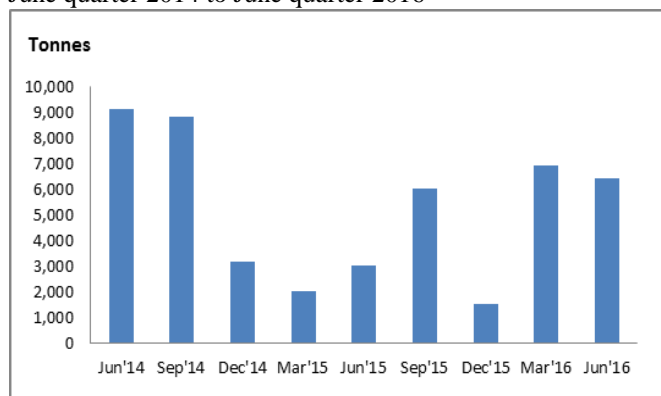
Copra Exports (refer to Tables 6.2, 6.3 and 6.4)

- In June quarter 2016, the quantity of copra exports registered a significant increase of 6,437 tonnes, representing an increase of 113% or 3,419 tonnes compared to 3,018 tonnes over the same period in 2015.
- In value terms, copra exports increased by 135% or VT 235 million when compared to VT 174 million over June quarter 2015.
- Copra export receipts constituted 35% share of the total domestic exports in value for June quarter 2016.

June quarter 2014 to June quarter 2016



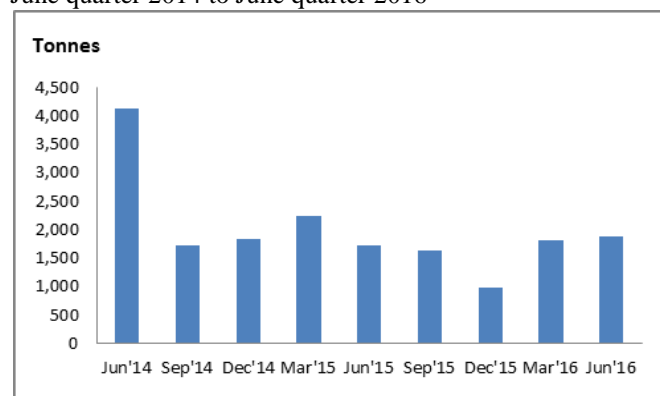
Coconut Oil (refer to Tables 6.2 and 6.3)

- In June quarter 2016, the quantity of coconut oil exports stood at 1,870 tonnes, representing an increase of 9% or 147 tonnes compared to 1,724 tonnes in June quarter of 2015.
- Coconut oil exports in value terms stood at VT 180 million in June quarter 2016, showing a decrease of 18% or VT 40 million from VT 220 million over June quarter 2015.
- The decrease is reflected by the fall in coconut oil average export price by 25% from VT 128 in June quarter 2015 to VT 96 in June quarter 2016.
- Coconut oil receipts constituted 15% of total domestic export value in June quarter 2016.

June quarter 2014 to June quarter 2016



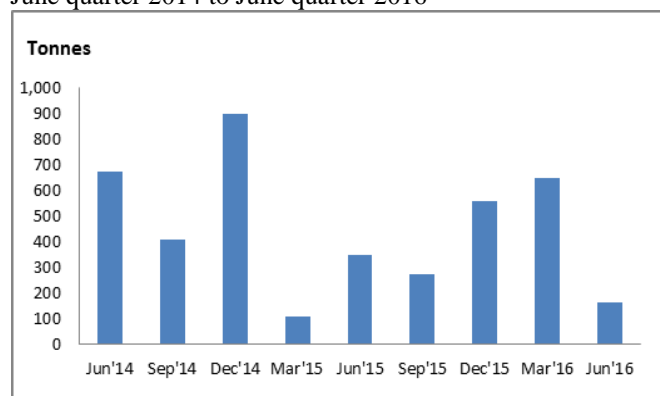
Cocoa Exports (refer to Tables 6.2, 6.3 and 6.4)

- The quantity of cocoa exports fell by 53% or 183 tonnes in June quarter of 2016 to 164 tonnes when compared to the same period in 2015.
- In value terms, cocoa exports in June quarter 2016 stood at VT 38 million, recording a decrease of 56% or VT 49 million. The decrease was reflected by the average cocoa export price at (8%) over June quarter 2015.
- Cocoa exports share of the total domestic exports value constituted 3% in June quarter 2016.

Beef (refer to Tables 6.2, 6.3 and 6.4)

- Beef exports decreased in quantity from 246 to 223 tonnes, (9%) in June quarter 2016 over June quarter 2015.
- In value terms, beef exports increased by 48% or VT 39 million over June quarter 2015 and 114% or VT 64 million over the previous quarter.

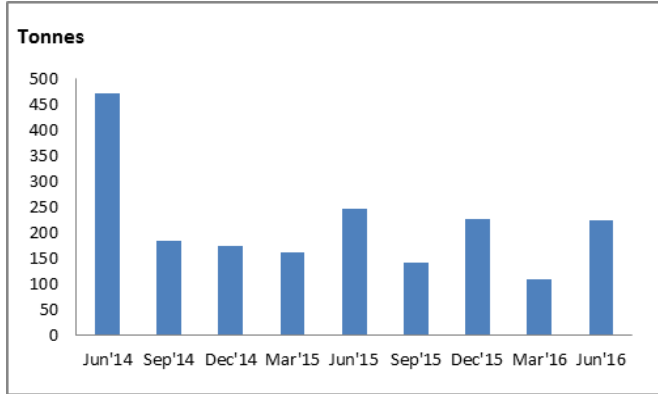
- The implied average beef export price decreased by 30% over the June quarter of 2015. However, it recorded a slight increase of 4% over the previous quarter.

- Beef exports value constituted 10% of the total domestic exports receipts in June quarter 2016.

June quarter 2014 to June quarter 2016



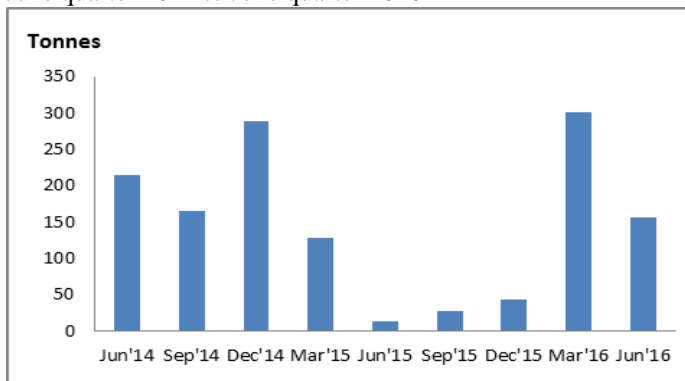
Kava (refer to Tables 6.2, 6.3 and 6.4)

- Kava exports in quantity recorded 156 tonnes in June quarter of 2016, representing an increase of 144 tonnes compared to 13 tonnes over the same period in 2015.
- In Value terms, kava exports stood at VT 181 million in June quarter 2016, indicating an increase of VT 162 million from VT 19 million in June quarter 2015. Kava exports share constituted 16% of the total domestic exports receipts in June quarter of 2016.
- The implied average kava export price decreased by 23% over the same period in 2015 and 12% over the previous quarter.

Quantity in tonnes

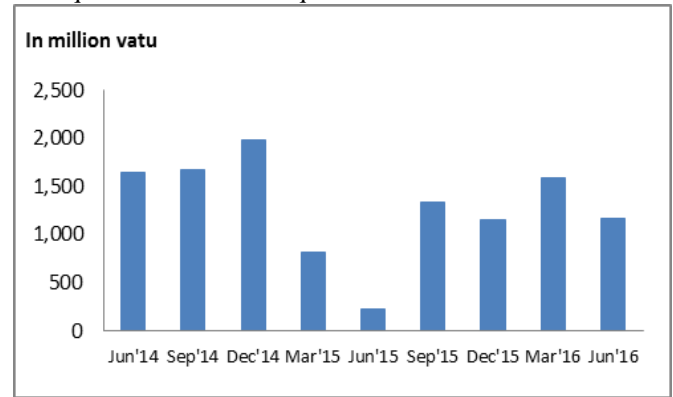
June quarter 2014 to June quarter 2016

June quarter 2014 to June quarter 2016



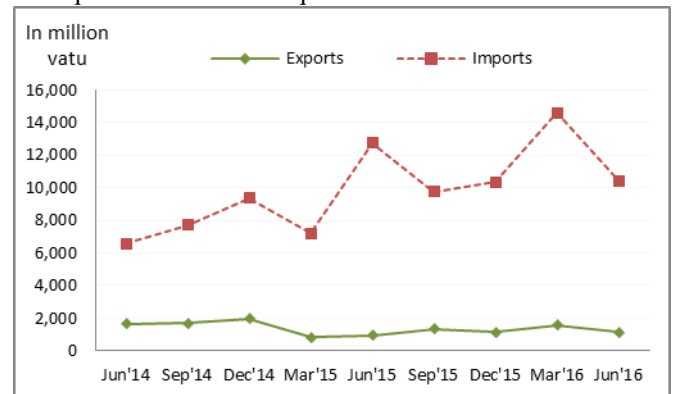
Domestic Exports (refer to Tables 6.1 and 6.5)

- According to June quarter 2016 provisional figures, the domestic export (excluding re-exports) earnings increased by 23% or VT 219 million, from VT 944 million to VT 1,164 million over the same period in 2015. The increase was driven mainly by increases in exports for copra, beef, kava and coconut oil.
- The exports by country of destination indicated that Australia registered the largest share of Vanuatu's main export with 35% or VT 411 million of total domestic exports in June quarter 2016 followed by Other Countries at 34%, Other MSG countries at 15%, New Zealand at 8%, New Caledonia at 5%. European Union Countries at 2%, Japan at 1% and South Korea recorded below (1%). Other Countries top five were comprised of Philippines, Singapore, Malaysia, Hong Kong and Kiribati.

Trade Deficit (refer to Table 6.1)

- Vanuatu's trade deficit (including re-exports) stood at VT 9,271 million in June quarter 2016. It deteriorated by 21%, but showing a slight improvement in deficit by VT 2,505 million compared to June quarter 2015 from VT 11,776 million.

- This slight improvement in the trade deficit is reflected by the decrease in total imports by 18% or VT 2,285 million in the June quarter of 2016 compared to the same period in 2015 from VT 12,720 million.

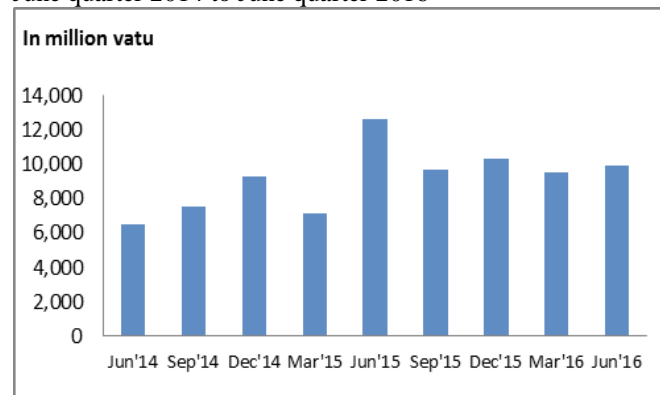
Imports for Home Consumption (refer to Tables 6.6 and 6.8)

- Imports for home consumption decreased in value at 22% or VT 2,728 million from VT 12,626 million in June quarter of 2015 to VT 9,898 million in June quarter of 2016.
- The imported commodity groups that contributed to this decrease were: mineral fuels at (50%), followed by basic manufactured goods at (46%), food and live animals at (43%), crude materials at (27%) and oils, fats and waxes at (7%). In contrast the rest of the imported items increased such as miscellaneous goods at 77%, beverages and tobacco at 24%, chemical products at 18%, machines and transport equipment at 15%, and goods not classified elsewhere at 434% or VT 23 million over June quarter 2015.
- In terms of share of commodity groups to total imports receipts, machines and transport equipment represented the largest value (C.I.F) of VT 2,346 million or (24%) of the total imports for home consumption, followed by basic manufactured goods at (23%), food and live animals (17%), miscellaneous goods (16%), chemical products (8%), mineral fuels (6%), beverages and tobacco (3%), crude materials at (2%). Other commodities such as goods not classified elsewhere and oils and fats made up less than 1% each of the total imports for home consumption.
- The total value of the selected ten major imported items decreased by 53% or VT 1,690 million, from VT 3,180 million in June quarter 2015 to VT 1,490 million in June quarter 2016
- Commodities that recorded increases were: Cement at VT 31 million or 18% in June quarter 2016 to VT 200 million compared to VT 169 million over June quarter 2015, followed by wheat flour at 10% or VT 12 million of the total value of the selected ten major imported items. However, the rest of the selected ten major imported items which decreased were: jet fuel at (-84%), rice at (-72%), distillate fuels at (-49%), pharmaceuticals at (-6%), motor spirits at (-5%) and cigarettes and tobacco at (-4%) while imports of motor vehicle transport and personal effects remains the same over June quarter 2015.
- In terms of the share of the selected ten major imports receipts; Rice recorded the largest share at 28%, followed by distillate fuels at 26%, cement at 13%, pharmaceutical products at 10%, wheat flour at

8%, motor spirits at 7%, cigarettes and tobacco at 4%, jet fuel at 3%, while personal effects recorded less than 1% .

June quarter 2014 to June quarter 2016

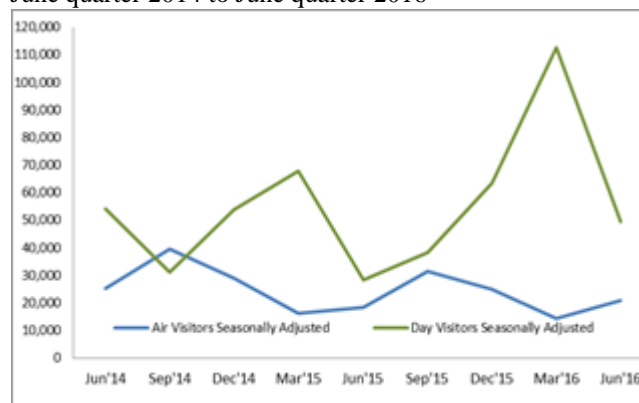


Tourism (refer to Tables 7.1 to 7.4)

- Total visitor¹ arrivals to Vanuatu in June quarter 2016 stood at 71,639, an increase of 50% over corresponding quarter of 2015 while it decreased by (-31%) over the previous quarter. The increase was reflected in the rise of air visitors into Vanuatu.

June quarter 2014 to June quarter 2016



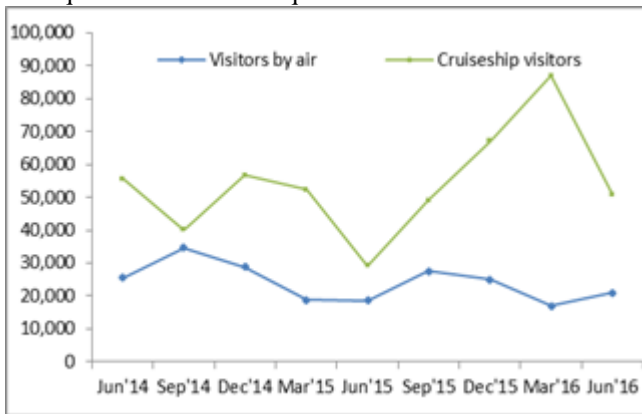
- The seasonally adjusted visitor arrivals depicted an increase of visitors by air for June quarter 2016 while day visitors declined.
- Visitor arrivals by Air accounted for 29% of international visitors to Vanuatu with a total of 20,983 visitors in June quarter 2016, indicating an increase of 12% over the same period in 2015 and 24% over the previous quarter.
- In June quarter 2016, Australian visitors made up 50% of visitors by air to Vanuatu.

¹ Visitors by air and cruise ship

- Countries that recorded an increase in visitor arrivals over corresponding quarter of 2015 were: Europe at 71% or 2,478 visitors; China at 54%; Japan at 43%; Australia at 15% and New Caledonia at 9%, while countries that recorded a decline included: Other pacific countries at (-13%); New Zealand and other countries at (-10%) each.
- Holiday visitors accounted for 72% of visitors by air; visitors who arrived for business, meetings or conferences at 11%; visitors to visit friends and relatives at 9%; visitors arriving for other purposes at 7% and visitors on transit to other countries at 1%.
- Day visitors made up 71% of total international visitors to Vanuatu in June quarter 2016. It shows an increase of 74% over the corresponding quarter of 2015 while it decreased by (-42%) over the previous quarter. The increase was attributed by a rise in the number of cruise ships to Vanuatu in June quarter 2016.

June quarter 2014 to June quarter 2016

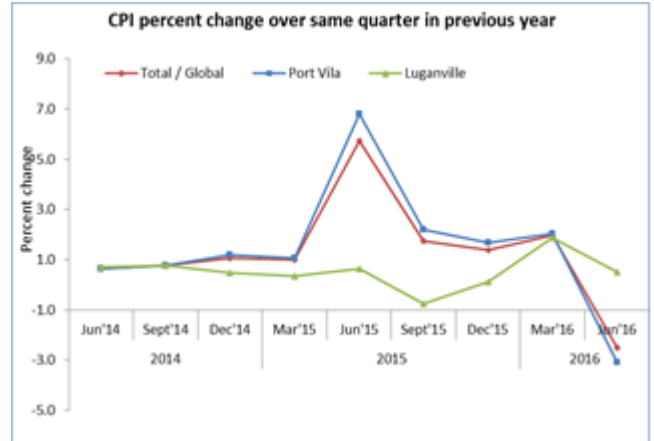


Consumer Price Index (refer to Tables 4.1 and 4.2)

- The Consumer Price Index (CPI) of June 2016 indicated a slight increase of (0.2 %). Port Vila slightly increased by (0.3%), while Luganville index decreased by (-0.7%) compared to the previous quarter. When compared to the June quarter of 2015, the Vanuatu index decreased by (-2.5%), Port Vila index decrease by (-3.1%) while Luganville index indicated a slight increase of (0.5%).

- At national level, the expenditure groups that contributed to the decrease over the same quarter of last year were: Food (-6.6%), Housing Utilities (-2.4%), Miscellaneous (-2.3%), Health (-0.8%), Communication (-0.5%). Thus, the decreases in these expenditure groups were the result of decreases in price movements of Fruits and Vegetables, Electricity supply charges, Automotive Fuels, and oils Prescription of drugs, and mobile phones. However, the three groups that recorded an offsetting raise were Transport (+5.0%) Education (+4.7%), Recreation (+1.7%), Household supplies and Clothing and Footwear (+1.3%) respectively, and Drinks and Tobacco (+0.4%).

Summary of Government Revenue and Expenditure

Total Government Operation (TGO) (refer to Table 5.1)*

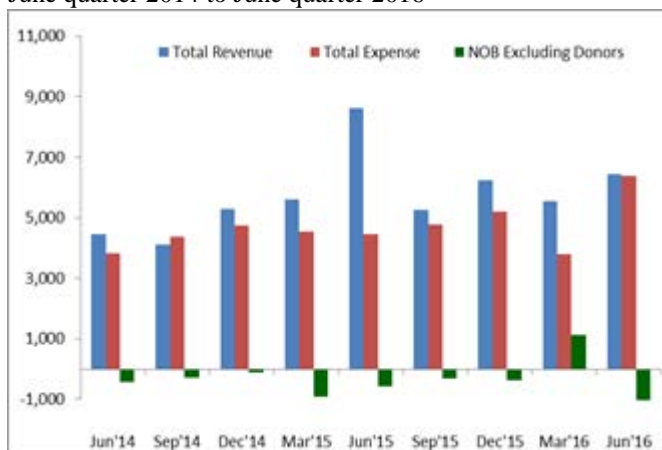
- In June quarter 2016, the total government revenue stood at VT 6,431.7 million comprising of recurrent budget at 67.4% and grants received from abroad at 32.6%. The total revenue decreased by (-25.5%) over the corresponding quarter of 2015 while it indicated an increase of 15.7% over the previous quarter.
- Total government expenditure increased by 43.4% over the same period in 2015

June quarter 2014 to June quarter 2016



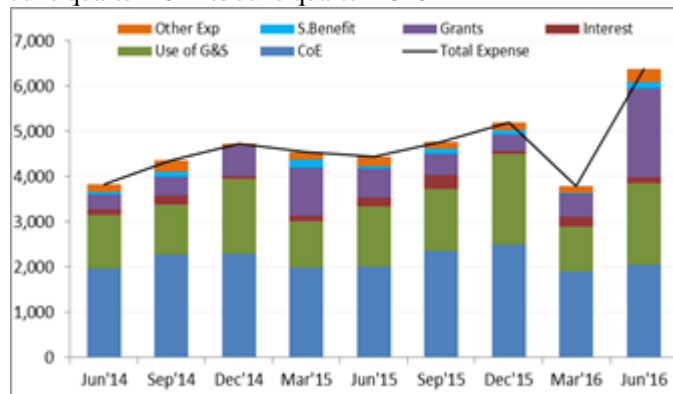

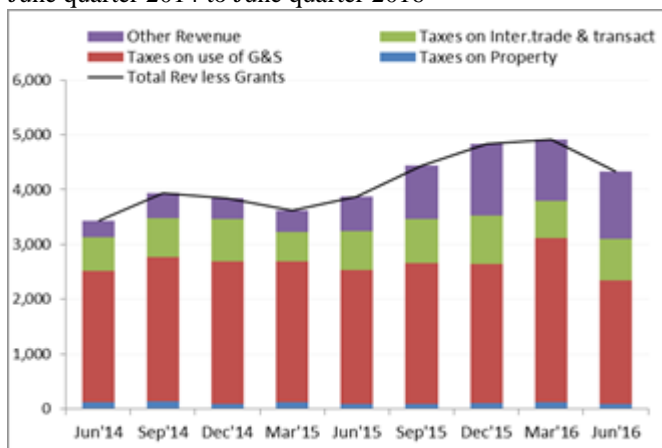
Government Revenue (refer to Table 5.1)

- Total revenue excluding donors amounted to VT 4,335.2 million showing an increase of 11.9% over the same period in 2015. However, it decreased by 11.8% over the previous quarter. The total taxes collected in June quarter 2016 was VT 3,095.1 million, a decrease of (-4.7%) over the corresponding quarter 2015 and (-18.3%) over the previous quarter.

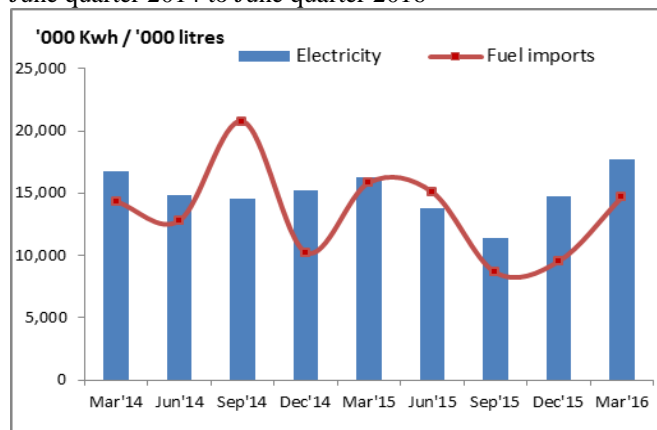
Energy Consumption (refer to Table 3)

- The total energy consumption as expressed in kilowatts for June quarter 2016 stood at 15,909 kilowatts, indicating an increase of 16% over June quarter 2015, however it declined by (-10%) over the previous quarter. The increase over June quarter 2015 was attributed by the rise of energy consumption in Tanna at 101% or 99 kilowatts; Port Vila at 16%; Luganville at 12% and Malekula at 10%.

Government Expenditure (refer to Table 5.1)

- In June quarter 2016, the total government expenditure stood at VT 6,377.5 million, an increase of 43.4% over corresponding quarter in 2015 and 68.2% over March quarter 2016.
- Compensation of employees accounted for 32.3% or VT 2,060.9 million of total expenses in June quarter 2016. It showed an increase of 2.2% over the

- In June quarter 2016, the total volume of imported petrol, diesel and kerosene stood at 13,042 litres, showing a decline of 14% or 2,051 litres over June quarter 2015 while it increased by 11% or 1,319 litres over the previous quarter.

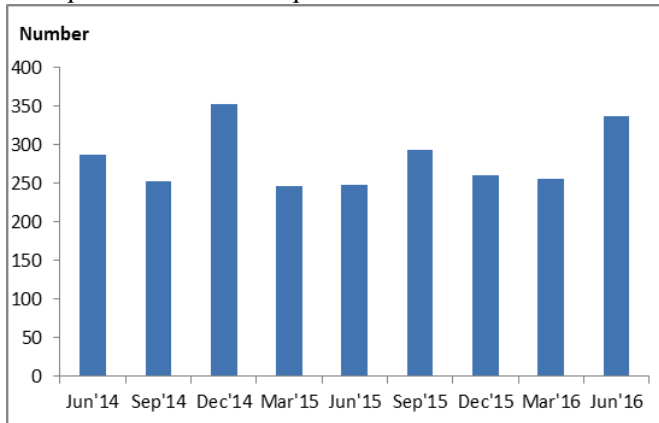
- This can be explained by changes made to fuel commodity classifications for imports of Petrol and kerosene compared to June quarter 2015.

New Motor Vehicle Registration (refer to Table 9)

- The total number of motor vehicle registrations for June quarter 2016 stood at 337, showing an increase of 36% over June quarter 2015. However it increased by 32% over the previous quarter.
