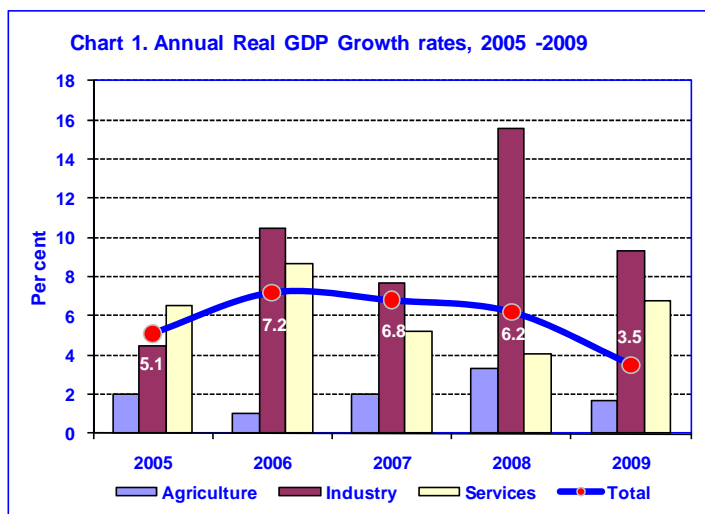
Provisional 2009 Gross Domestic Product (GDP) Estimates

The Vanuatu National Statistics Office is pleased to release the provisional estimates for 2009 Gross Domestic Product (GDP). This is the second release of the new series after the Preliminary results of the National Accounts rebasing that was undertaken in 2009. The intensive exercise required a considerable amount of time on data cleaning, reclassification and reconciliation for the period 1998-2009. This was the main contributing factor to the delay of this release. The timeliness of the 2009 GDP estimates was also hampered by NSO's major 2010 project; the Household Income and Expenditure Survey 2010 (HIES 2010).

Output

According to the provisional estimates for the 2009 GDP, Vanuatu's economic conditions pointed to an economy that continues to expand, but with a decelerating trend since 2007.

Vanuatu's economy registered a growth of 3.5 per cent in real terms; it shows a slower growth compared to consistent higher growths recorded during the last six years. The economic slowdown in 2009 was attributable to lower performing Agriculture and Industry sectors, while an expansion in Service sector in 2009 was not sufficient to outdo the 2008 economic growth.



The service sector achieved a growth of 6.8 per cent indicating a 2.7 points improvement from 2008. The growth is underpinned by high performances in accommodation and food services (16%), information and communication (31%), professional scientific, technical and administrative services (14%), and transport services (12%). Moderate contributions were from Public Administration (7%), Finance and Insurances (5%), and retail trade (4%) while Real Estate and Motor vehicles recorded low growth. The high growth in Information and communication was in line with the improvement in telecommunication policy, while the improvement in Accommodation and Food Services reflects the high record of more than 100,000 visitors in 2009.

Agriculture sector grew by 1.7 per cent. The slight growth in the sector was driven by Animal production especially other livestock, forestry, fishery, cocoa and kava in 2009. The weak performance in Agricultural activities could be explained by the low copra production in 2009 which was due to the fall in copra price. The price were sliced by almost a half (- 48%), from an average price of Vatu 44,000 in 2008 to Vatu 23,000 per tone in 2009. The low growth was also attributable to the temporary closure of the Luganville coconut oil mill factory which was on receivership until late 2009.

The industry sector registered a lower growth of 9 per cent in real terms compared to almost 16 per cent growth in 2008. In exception of the manufacturing industry, all other components of the industry sector such as electricity and water and construction recorded positive growths. The improvement in the sector was mainly due to a 54 per cent growth in construction which more than offset the contraction in manufacturing industry. Most manufacturing businesses experienced set back in 2009 after an impressive overall growth of 14 per cent in 2008. However, the growth in construction industry reflects the MCA's infrastructure projects.

Gross Domestic Product (GDP) at current price was estimated at Vatu 63,024 million in 2009, registering a nominal growth of 4.8 per cent. The GDP deflator which measures the price change of all goods produce in the economy increased by 1.3 in 2009 compare to 4.8 per cent in 2008. The change in Implicit Price Deflator for 2008 somehow reflected the high inflation during that year, whereas the 2009 IPD change was far less than 2009 annual CPI. This was due to declining IPDs in electricity and water, information and communication, accommodation and food services, and the public administration.

Concepts and definitions

The output of an economy, if restricted to the process of production, is the part of the output that reaches the final consumers. Vanuatu's output, GDP, in this release is measured from the production side. The NSO GDP rebasing also covers the GDP from the expenditure side which looks at the use of the output, however these annual estimates will be published only when the quality of the quarterly series for the expenditure components are satisfactory.

a. Output

Total output, or total value added, is measured as final output from all businesses less intermediate imports going into the production process. This is achieved by considering how each business or enterprise adds value to the inputs it receives, so that the output of the business is measured in terms of the value added by means of its production activities.

For a single enterprise, value added by production activity is measured as gross output less inputs from other businesses less inputs from abroad.

Summing up the value added by all enterprises, the domestic intermediate transactions between businesses cancel out. For the total economy, value added from the production side is measured as gross output less inputs from abroad (imports).

b. Intermediate Inputs

Goods and services, other than fixed assets, used as inputs into the production process of an establishment that are produced elsewhere in the economy or are imported. They may be either transformed or used up by the production process. Land, labour, and capital are primary inputs and are not included among intermediate inputs.

c. Implicit Price Deflators (IPD's)

It is the Current Vatu GDP divided by Constant Vatu GDP. IPDs therefore have current year's weights, rather than being "base weighted" like the CPI. The IPDs are expressed as 2006=100. This ratio is used to account for the effects of inflation, by reflecting the change in the prices of the bundle of goods and services that make up the GDP as well as the changes to the bundle itself.

d. GDP per Capita

It is an approximation of the value of goods and services produced per person in Vanuatu, and it is equal to the country's GDP divided by the total number of people in the country. The total number of population was from the 2009 Population Census.
