Overall, about

14.7%

of the total population aged 5+ reported a disability in Vanuatu, regardless of severity



1 in 7 people

“Promote, protect and ensure the full and equal enjoyment of all human rights and fundamental freedoms by all persons with disabilities and to promote respect for their inherent dignity” – United Nations Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities

1.7% of the population aged 5+ reported a major disability*

1% more female with disability than male**

of the population had severe or total visual disability



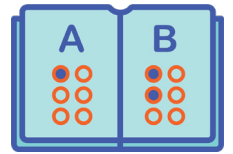
0.93%

3 in 50 young people aged 5–24 years people had a disability of any level of severity.

- From age 40, the proportion of the population with a disability increased continuously.
- More than half of the population aged 60+ years reported a disability
