OVERVIEW

Copra and Cocoa Production (refer to Table 1.1)¹

- Copra production figures for March quarter 2021 decreased in volume by 25% or 1,054 tonnes from 4,239 tonnes to 3,185 tonnes over the March quarter of 2020. It also decrease over the previous quarter by less than 1%.
- Copra producers' price per tonne increase by 19% or VT 7,402 from VT 38,257 to VT 45,659 in the March quarter of 2021 over the corresponding period in 2020 and also an increase of 1% over the previous quarter.
- Cocoa production in volume remains constant in the March quarter of 2021 compared to the March quarter of 2020. However it decreased by 62% over the previous quarter. The recorded value of cocoa production increased slightly by 4% over the corresponding quarter in 2020 but it went down by 64% over the previous quarter.
- Cocoa producer's price per tonne increased by 6% or VT 8,978 in the March quarter of 2021 compared to the same period in 2020 from VT 154,920 per tonne to VT 163,898 per tonne.

Cattle Production (refer to Table 1.2)

- The total number of cattle heads slaughtered in March quarter 2021 stood at 2,251. Comparing cattle head slaughter to the same quarter in 2020 it went down by 12% and 6% over the previous quarter.

Copra exports (refer to tables 6.2, 6.3 and 6.4)

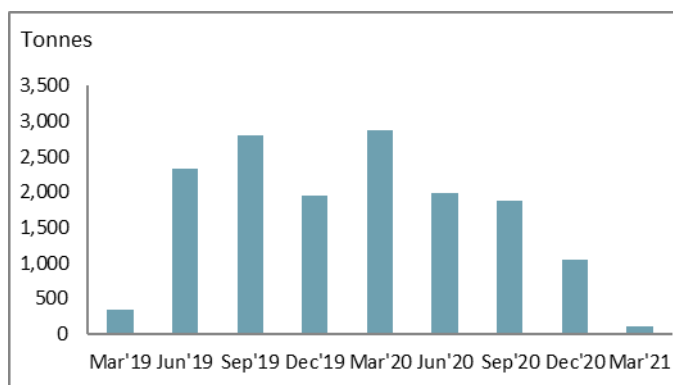
- In March quarter 2021, the quantity of copra exports declined by 96% or 2,763 tonnes over March quarter of 2020 and also declined by 89% or 938 tonnes from 1,049 tonnes in the previous quarter to 111 tonnes.
- In value terms, copra exports decreased by 94% or VT 113 million over March quarter of 2020 and also decreased by 85% or 45 million over the previous quarter.

- Copra export receipts constituted a 1% share of the total domestic exports in value for March quarter 2021.
- The average export price of copra increased by 68% over the corresponding quarter in 2020 and also by 40% over the previous quarter.

Coconut Oil (refer to Tables 6.2, 6.3 and 6.4)

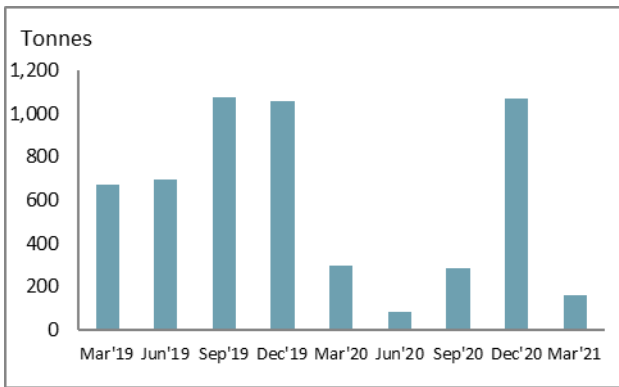
- The quantity of Coconut oil exports for March quarter 2021 decreased by 47% or 140 tonnes over March quarter of 2020. Also it went down by 85% or 914 tonnes over the previous quarter.
- In Value terms, coconut oil exports decreased by 30% or VT 7 million in March quarter 2021 over March quarter 2020 and it also went down by 85% or VT 93 million over the previous quarter.
- The average export price of coconut oil increased by 31% in the March quarter 2021 over the same quarter of the previous year and increased by 4% over the December quarter of 2020.
- Coconut oil receipts constituted a 2% share of total domestic export value in March quarter 2021.

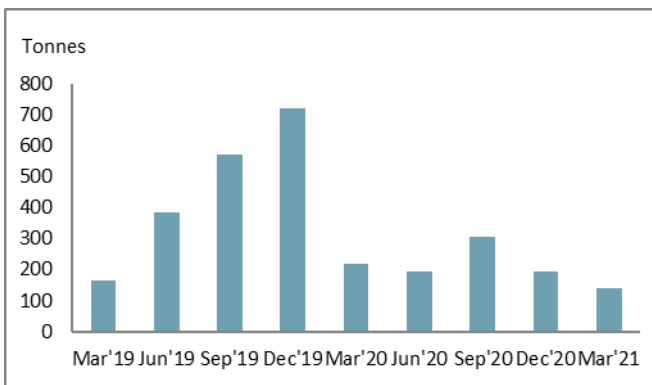


Cocoa Exports (refer to Tables 6.2, 6.3 and 6.4)

- In March quarter 2021, the quantity of cocoa exports decreased by 37% or 83 tonnes over March quarter of 2020, it also went down by 28% or 54 tonnes over the December quarter of 2020.
- In value terms, cocoa exports decreased by 41% or VT 16 million over the same quarter of 2020 and also decreased by 38% or VT 15 million over the previous quarter.
- Cocoa exports receipts constituted a 3% share of the total domestic exports value in March quarter 2020.

March quarter 2019 to March quarter 2021



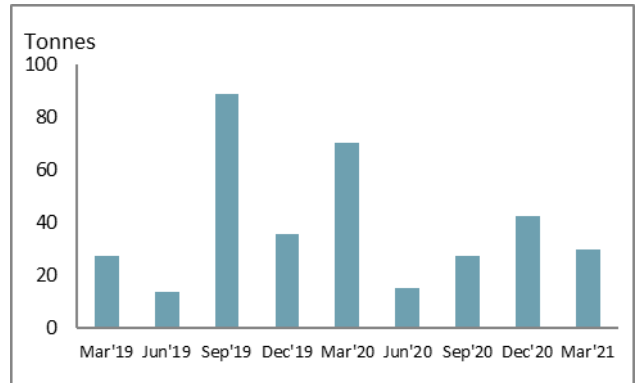
Beef (refer to Tables 6.2, 6.3 and 6.4)

- Beef exports decreased by 58% or 41 tonnes from 70 tonnes in March quarter 2020 to 30 tonnes in March quarter 2021. Furthermore, it also went down by 30% or 13 tonnes over the previous quarter.
- In value terms, beef exports decreased by 67% over March quarter of 2020.

- The average beef export price decreased by 22% over the March quarter 2020.
- Beef export value constituted a 2% share of the total domestic export receipts in March quarter 2021.

March quarter 2019 to March quarter 2021

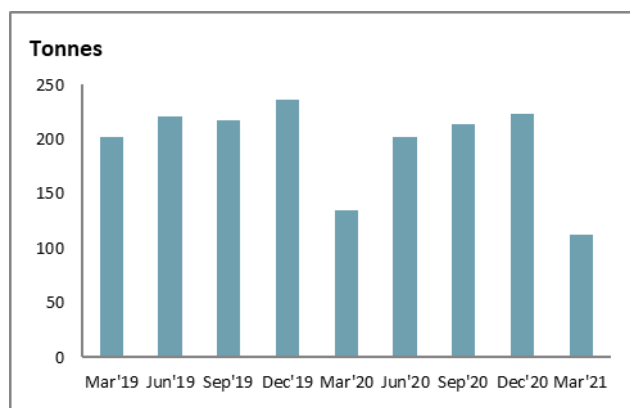


Kava (refer to Tables 6.2, 6.3 and 6.4)

- Kava exports in quantity decreased by 17% or 23 tonnes in March quarter of 2021 over March quarter 2020 and it also decreased by 50% or 111 tonnes over the previous quarter.
- In Value terms, kava exports stood at VT 438million in March quarter 2021 which is a decline of 10% or VT 47 million over the March quarter of 2020.
- Kava exports constituted a 64% share of the total domestic export receipts in March quarter 2021.
- The implied average kava export price increased by 9% over March quarter of 2020.

March quarter 2019 to March quarter 2021

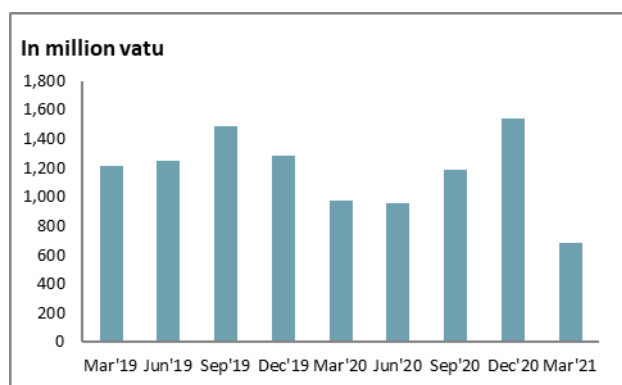


Domestic Exports (refer to Tables 6.1 and 6.5)

- In March quarter 2021, provisional figures in domestic export (excluding re-exports) earnings decreased by 30% or VT 289 million. The decrease was attributed to the decrease in exports of copra by 94%, beef by 67%, cocoa by 41%, coffee by 38%, fish by 36%, coconut oil by 30%, coconut meal by 19% and kava by 10% over March quarter 2020.

Share of Commodities to Main Countries of Export (refer to Table 6.5)

- The share of commodities to main countries of export destination include the following; Other MSG Countries at 12%, New Caledonia at 10%, Australia at 6% , New Zealand at 5%, European Community at 3% and South Korea at less than 1%. Other countries accounted for 64% share of the main exports destination. The top five countries which made up Other Countries

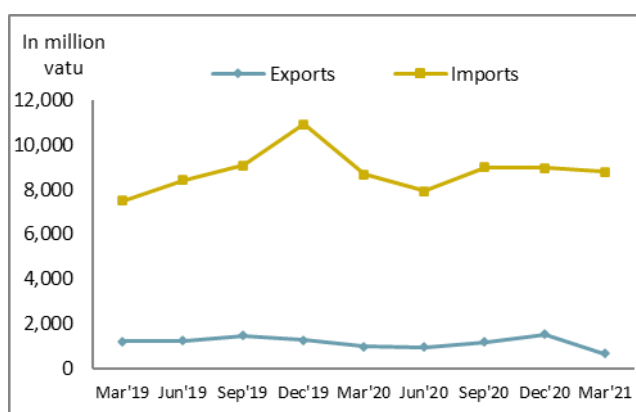
comprised of Kiribati, the United States of America, China, Malaysia and Indonesia.

Trade Deficit (refer to Table 6.1)

- Vanuatu's trade deficit stood at VT 8,086 million for March quarter 2021. The deficit continues to deteriorate when compared to the correspondence period in 2020 at VT 818 million and VT 707 million over the previous quarter.

Imports for Home Consumption (refer to Tables 6.6 and 6.8) – Domestic Demand

- Imports for home consumption increased in value by 9% or VT 622 million from VT 7,171 million in March quarter 2020 to VT 7,793 million in March quarter of 2021.

The imported commodity groups that contributed to this increase were: Goods not classified elsewhere by 47 million, oils, fats and waxes at 89%, mineral fuels at 56%, machines and transport equipment at 40% and beverages and tobacco at less than 1% over March quarter of 2020.

- In terms of share of commodity groups to total imports receipts, machines and transport equipment made up the largest value (C.I.F) of VT 2,255 million or 29% of the total imports for home consumption, followed by mineral fuels at 18%, food and live animals at 16%, basic manufactured products at 13%, miscellaneous manufactured goods at 11%, chemical products at 6%, beverages and tobacco at 4%, crude materials except fuels at 2%, goods not elsewhere classified at 1% and oils, fats and

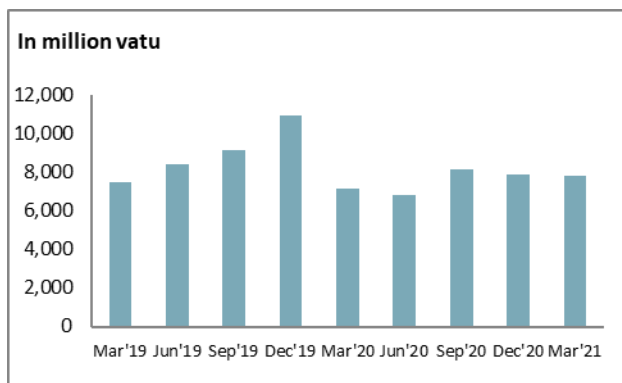
waxes at less than 1% of the total imports for home consumption.

- The total value of the selected ten major imported items decreased by 23% or VT 574 million from VT 2,506 million in corresponding quarter of 2020 to VT 1,932 million in March quarter 2021.
- The commodities that decreased were: Personal household effects at 100% followed by Jet fuel and aviation kerosene at 82%, pharmaceutical products at 60%, wheat flour at 42%, distillate fuel at 21%, motor spirit at 10%, cigarettes and tobacco at 1%. However, the commodities which increased were: Rice at 44% and cement at 26% of the total value of the selected ten major imported items over the March quarter of 2020.
- In terms of the share of the selected ten major imports receipts; Distillate fuels recorded the largest share at 52%, followed by motor spirit at 13% , rice at 11%, cigarettes and tobacco at 7%, cement at 6%, pharmaceutical products at 5%, wheat flour at 3% and jet fuel and aviation kerosene at 2%.

March quarter 2019 to March quarter 2021

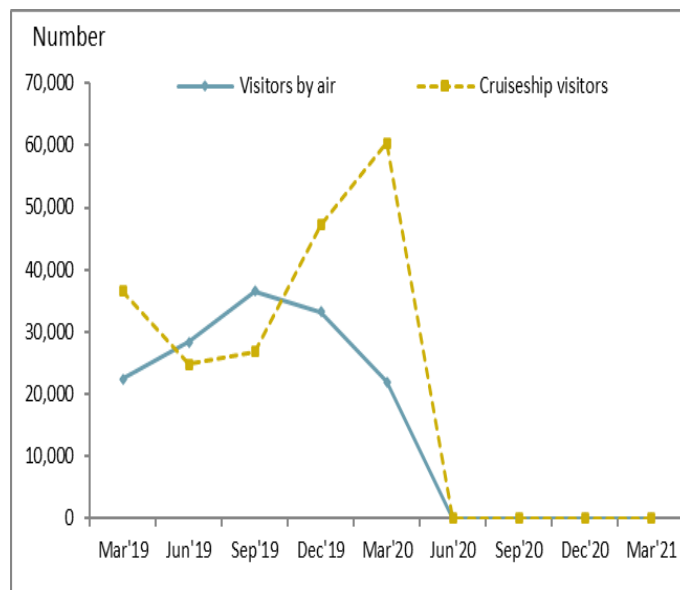


Tourism (refer to Tables 7.1 to 7.4)

- There are no international visitor arrivals to Vanuatu for March quarter of 2021. The decrease of visitor arrivals over corresponding period was attributed by the lockdown of international flights due to the covid-19 pandemic .
- There are only repatriation flights recorded for disembarking residents for this quarter.

March quarter 2019 to March quarter 2021

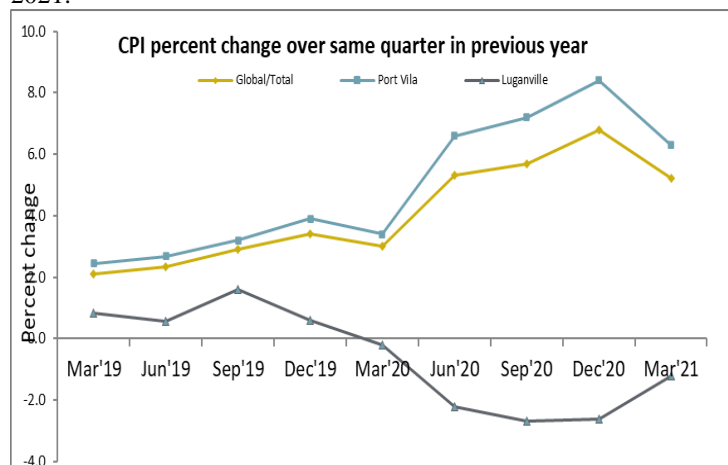


Consumer Price Index (refer to Tables 4.1 and 4.2)

- The Consumer Price Index (CPI) of March quarter 2021 indicated a decrease of (-0.5%). Port Vila decreased by (-0.6%) and Luganville decreased by (-0.1%) compared to the previous quarter. When compared to the March quarter of 2020, the Vanuatu index increased by (+5.2%). Port Vila index increased by (+6.3%) while Luganville index slightly decreased by (-1.2%).

- At the national level, the expenditure groups that contributed to the increase over the same quarter of last year were: Food (+11.7%), Drinks and Tobacco (+3.8%), Health (+3.5%), Transportation (+1.7%), Recreation (+1.1%), Miscellaneous (+0.8%), Education (+0.3%) and Communication (+0.1%). The increase in these expenditure groups were driven by the increase in price movements of

Root crops, Fruits and Vegetables, prescription of medical drugs and mobile phones.

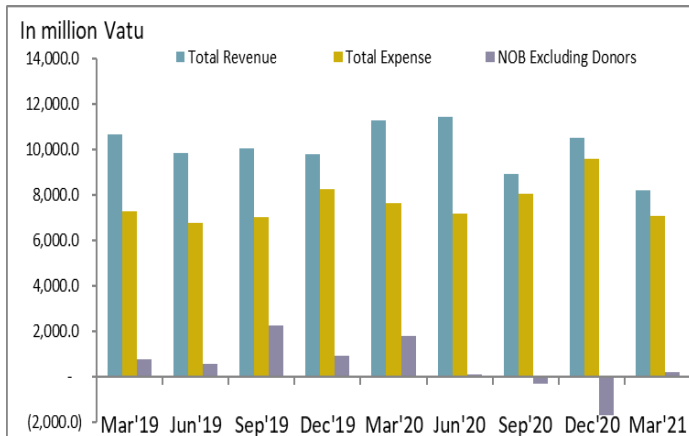
Summary of Government Revenue and Expenditure

Total Government Operation (TGO) (refer to Table 5.1)²

- The total government revenue for March quarter 2021 stood at VT 8,193 million of which 88% is recurrent revenue while 12% were grants received from abroad. Total revenue decreased by 27% over corresponding period in 2020 and 22% over the previous quarter.
- The total government expenditure for March quarter decreased by 7% over corresponding period in 2020 and also decreased by 26% over December quarter 2020.

March 2019 to March 2021



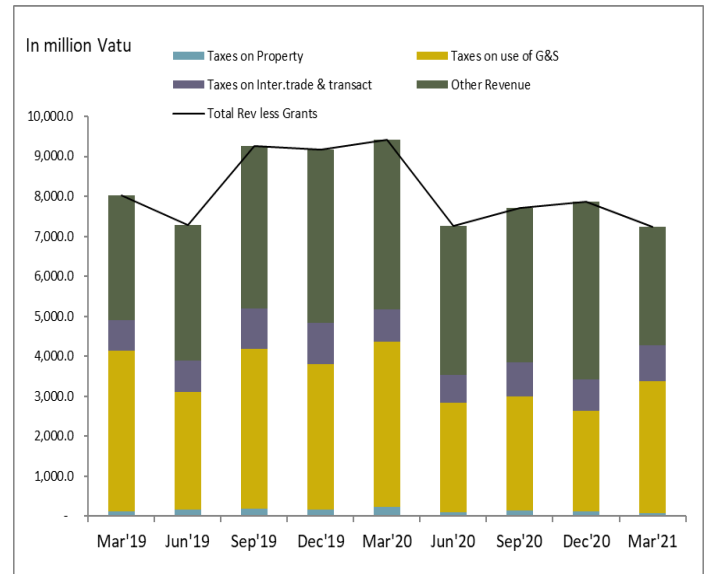

Government Revenue (refer to Table 5.1)

- The total government revenue excluding donors in March quarter 2021 stood at VT 7,234 million. This is a decrease of 23% over corresponding period in 2020 and 8% over the previous quarter. The total tax revenue collected for March quarter totalled VT 4,273 million, it is a decrease of 17% over March quarter 2020 but it increased by 25% over the previous quarter.

March quarter 2019 to March quarter 2021



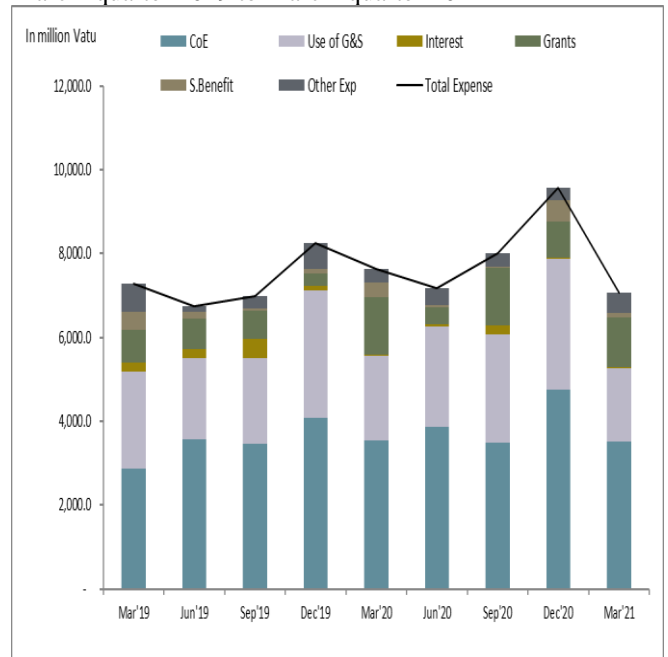

Government Expenditure (refer to Table 5.1)

- The total government expenditure in March quarter 2021 stood at VT 7,067 million. Compensation of employees made up 50% or VT 3,526 million of total government expenditure in March quarter 2021. This is a decrease of less than 1% compared to March quarter in 2020 and also a decrease by 26% over the previous quarter.

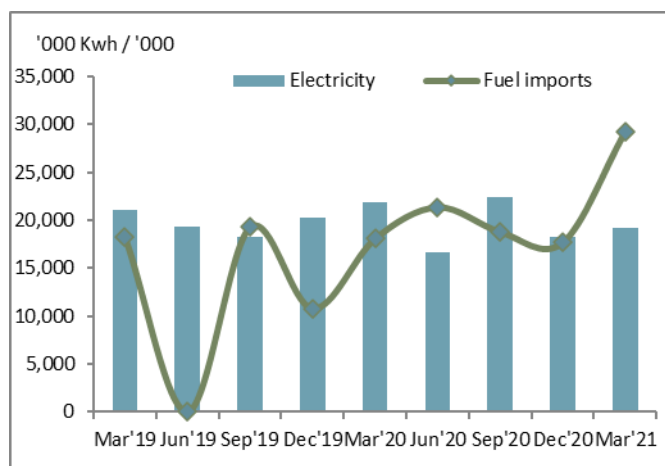
Energy Consumption (refer to Table 3)

- The total energy consumed (expressed in Kilowatts) for March quarter 2021 stood at 19,172. This decreased by 12% over corresponding period in 2020 but it increased by 5% over the previous quarter. The contributors to the decrease of electricity consumption were Port Vila at 14%, Luganville at 5% and Malekula at 4%.

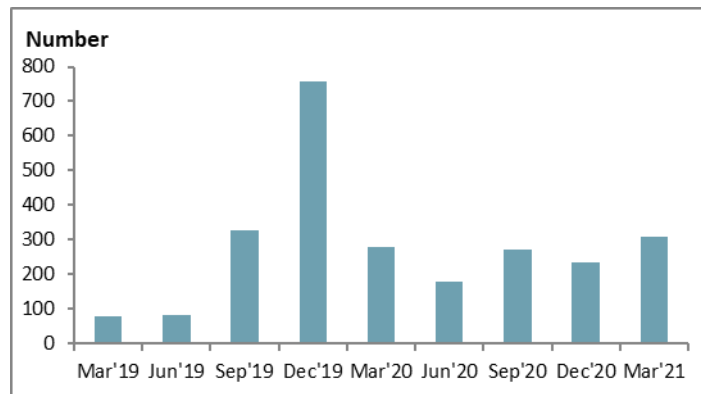
- The total volume of imported petrol, diesel and kerosene stood at 29,231 litres in March quarter of 2021, an increase of 62% over the same quarter of 2020 and also an increase of 65% over the previous quarter

- The total number of new private motor vehicle registrations in Port Vila and Luganville stood at 307. This is an increase of 10% over corresponding period in 2020 and an increase of 32% over the previous quarter .
