## OVERVIEW

### Cattle Production (refer to Table 1.)

- The total number of cattle heads slaughtered by abattoirs for June quarter stood at 2,269, this is a decrease of 22% over corresponding period in 2017 and also an decrease of 5% over the previous quarter.


### Copra exports (refer to tables 6.2 and 6.3)

- In June quarter 2018, the quantity of copra exports recorded a huge downfall at 80% or 6,641 tonnes over the June quarter 2017. Compared to the previous quarter, it also recorded an increase of 1,361 tonnes from 291 tonnes.
- In value terms, copra exports decreased by 78% or VT 527 million over the June quarter 2017.
- Copra export receipts constituted a 12% share of the total domestic exports in value for June quarter 2018.

### Coconut Oil (refer to Tables 6.2, 6.3 and 6.4)

- In June quarter 2018, the quantity of coconut oil exports decreased by 33% or 543 tonnes compared to 1,637 tonnes in the June quarter 2017.
- In Value terms, coconut oil exports stood at VT 116 million in June quarter 2018, showing a decrease of 32% or VT 56 million compared to VT 172 million in the same quarter of the previous year. Compared to the previous quarter, it also decreased by 10%.


- The average export price of coconut oil increased slightly by 1% in the June quarter 2018, compared to the same quarter of the previous year.

- Coconut oil receipts constituted 10% of total domestic export value in June quarter 2018.

June quarter 2016 to June 2018




### Cocoa Exports (refer to Tables 6.2, 6.3 and 6.4)

- In June quarter 2018, the quantity of cocoa exports increased by 31% or 70 tonnes over the June quarter of 2017.
- In value terms, cocoa exports increased by 54% or VT 20 million compared to the same quarter of 2017.
- Cocoa exports receipts constituted a 5% share of the total domestic exports value in June quarter 2018.

June quarter 2016 to June quarter 2018




## Beef (refer to Tables 6.2, 6.3 and 6.4)

- Beef exports recorded a downfall of 58% or 41 tonnes in June quarter 2018 from 71 tonnes in June quarter 2017.
- In value terms, beef exports fell by 61% or VT 24 million over June quarter 2017.
- The average beef export price decreased by 7% over the June quarter 2017. Average export price increased over previous quarter.
- Beef export value constituted a 1% share of the total domestic export receipts in June quarter 2018.

Quantity in tonnes


June quarter 2016 to June quarter 2018

Quantity in tonnes


June quarter 2016 to June quarter 2018

June quarter 2016 to June quarter 2018




## Domestic Exports (refer to Tables 6.1 and 6.5)

- In the June quarter 2018 provisional figures, the domestic export (excluding re-exports) earnings decreased by 1% or VT 9 million, The decrease was attributed to decreases in exports for copra, coconut oil and beef over June quarter 2017.
- The exports by country of destination indicated that Other Countries registered the largest share of Vanuatu's main export with 62% or VT 738 million of total domestic exports in June quarter 2018, followed by Other MSG countries at 14%, Australia at 10%, New Caledonia at 8%, European Community at 5%, Japan and New Zealand at 1% each, while South Korea recorded less than (1%). Other Countries top five were comprised of Philippines, Malaysia, Hong Kong, China, and the United States of America.

## Trade Summary

### Trade Deficit (refer to Table 6.1)

- Vanuatu's trade deficit stood at VT 7,732 million in June quarter 2018. It improved by (-2%) or VT 128 million, compared to June quarter 2017.
- The improvement in the trade deficit is reflected by the slight increases in total imports by 4% or VT 330 million in the June quarter of 2018 and the significant increase in total exports by 52% or VT 626 million respectively. The increase in total exports is attributed to re exports in June quarter 2018.

### Imports for Home Consumption (refer to Tables 6.6 and 6.8)

- Imports for home consumption increased in value at 4% or VT 331 million from VT 9,029 million in June quarter 2017 to VT 9,359 million in June quarter of 2018.
- The imported commodity groups that contributed to this increase were: crude materials at VT 349 million from VT 146 million in June 2017 to VT 495 million in June 2018, followed by machines and transport equipment at 35%, goods not classified elsewhere at 9%, food and live animals at 4% and chemical products at 2%.
- In contrast the rest of the imported items decreased, such as, mineral fuels at (29%), followed by oils and fats at (28%), basic manufactured goods at (24%), beverages and tobacco at (13%), and miscellaneous goods at (4%).
- In terms of share of commodity groups to total imports receipts, machines and transport equipment represented the largest value (C.I.F) of VT 2,902 million or 31% of the total imports for home consumption, followed by food and live animals at 20%, basic manufactured goods at 13%, mineral fuels at 11%, miscellaneous goods at 8%, chemical products at 7%, crude materials

at 5%, beverages and tobacco at 3%, goods not classified elsewhere at 2%, however, other commodities such as oils and fats made up less than 1% of the total imports for home consumption.

- The total value of the selected ten major imported items decreased by 26% or VT 559 million from VT 2,170 million in June quarter 2017 to VT 1,612 million in June quarter 2018.


The commodities that contributed to this decrease were: Personal household effects at 100%, followed by motor spirit at (51%), distillate fuels at (35%), cement at (28%), pharmaceutical products at (22%), rice at (12%), wheat flour at (9%) and Jet fuel and aviation kerosene at (5%) except for cigarettes and tobacco which recorded an increase of 38% or VT 33 million of the total value of the selected ten major imported items over the June quarter 2018.

In terms of the share of the selected ten major imports receipts; Distillate fuels recorded the largest share at 39%, followed by rice at 15%, jet fuel and aviation kerosene at 10%, cement at 8%, cigarettes and tobacco, pharmaceutical products and wheat flour at 7%, each, motor spirit at 6% and, while the rest of the commodities recorded less than 1%.

### Tourism (refer to Tables 7.1 to 7.4)


- Total visitors<sup>1</sup> arrival to Vanuatu in June quarter 2018 totalled 82,466, an increase of 22% over corresponding quarter 2017 while it declined by 25% over the previous quarter. The increase was reflected by the number of visitor arrivals for holiday.

## Quarterly Total visitors


Seasonally adjusted visitor arrivals

June quarter 2016 to June quarter 2018




- The seasonally adjusted visitor arrivals depicted a decline of air visitors for June quarter 2018, while day visitors increased.
- Visitor arrivals by air made up 35% of all international visitors to Vanuatu with a total of 28,619 visitors in June quarter 2018. This is an increase of 12% over same period in 2017 and 22% over the previous quarter.
- Australian visitors accounted for 52% of all visitor arrivals by air in June quarter 2018.
- Countries that recorded an increase over corresponding quarter of 2017 were; North America at 20%; China at 19%; Other pacific countries at 17%; New Zealand at 14%; Europe at 13%; Australia and Japan at 9%; New Caledonia at 6% and visitors from other countries at 50%.
- Holiday visitors made up 78% of visitors by air; visitors who arrived to visit friends and relatives, business, meetings and conferences and other purposes at 7% each while visitors on transit at 1%.
- Day visitors made up 65% of total international visitors to Vanuatu in June quarter 2018. It showed an increase of 28% over the corresponding quarter of 2017 while it declined by 38% over the previous quarter. The increase was attributed by the rise in the number of day visitors to Vanuatu in June quarter 2018.

## Consumer Price Index (refer to Tables 4.1 and 4.2)

- The Consumer Price Index (CPI) of June quarter 2018 indicated an increase of (+0.5%). Port Vila and Luganville both increased by (+0.4%) respectively over March quarter 2018. When compared over the corresponding quarter in 2017, the Vanuatu index increased by (+2.3%), the Port Vila index increased by (+2.9%) while Luganville index declined by (-0.7%).

## Inflation Rate

- At the national level, the expenditure groups that contributed to the increase over corresponding quarter in 2017 were; Food and Household supplies at (+4.3%) each; Recreation at (+3.4%); Alcoholic drinks at (+2.9%); Housing and utilities at (+2.0%); Health and Transport at (+1.9%) each; Miscellaneous at (+1.5%); Clothing and footwear at (+1.3%). The increases were attributed by the increase in price of root crops, fruits and vegetables, motels, wines and spirits, housing furniture's, purchasing and hiring of motor vehicle and international airline tickets. The other expenditure groups that decreased were Education at (-11.1%) and Communication at (-0.2%).

## Summary of Government Revenue and Expenditure

### Total Government Operation (TGO)



- The total government revenue in June quarter 2018 totalled VT 8,956.6 million of which 78.7% is recurrent revenue while 21.3% were grants received from abroad. Total government revenue increased over corresponding quarter 2017 and also over the previous quarter of 2018.
- The government's total expenditure increased by 6.7% in June quarter 2018 over corresponding quarter in 2017.

### Government Revenue (refer to Table 5.1)

- The total revenue excluding donors totalled VT 7,046.2 million, an increase of 39.4% over corresponding quarter in 2017. It declined by 2.8% over March quarter 2018. The total tax revenue collected stood at VT 4,215.3 million, an increase of 15.9% over corresponding period in 2017 while it declined by 12.1% over March quarter 2018.


### Government Expenditure (refer to Table 5.1)

- The total government expenditure stood at VT 5,955.7 in June quarter 2018, this is an increase of 6.7% over corresponding period in 2017 while it declined by 2.4% over previous quarter in 2018.
- The Compensation of employees made up the highest government expense at 56.0% or VT 3,335.6 million in June 2018. This is an increase of 28.8% over corresponding quarter in 2017 and an increase of 36.5% over March quarter 2018.

### Energy Consumption (refer to Table 3)

- The total energy consumption (expressed in kilowatts) for June quarter 2018 totalled 16,849. This is a slight increase of less than 1% over the corresponding period in 2017 while it declined by 9% over the previous quarter. The slight increase over June quarter 2017 was attributed by the increase in electricity consumption in Tanna at



16% and Port Vila at less than 1% while Luganville electricity consumption declined by 1%. Electricity consumption in Malekula, Tanna and Luganville increased by 16%, 6% and less than 1% respectively over the previous quarter while Port Vila declined by 11%.

- In June quarter 2018, the total volume of imported petrol, diesel and kerosene stood at 11,529 litres, reflecting decreases over the June quarter of 2017 by 44% and 5% compared to the March quarter of 2018.


## **New Motor Vehicle Registration**

- The total number of new private motor vehicle registered in June quarter 2018 stood at 445, this increased by 8% over the corresponding quarter in 2017 while it declined by 4% over the previous quarter.
