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
PREFACE

OVERVIEW

Cattle Production (refer to Table 1.)

- The total number of cattle heads slaughtered for June quarter 2019 stood at 2,375. This is an increase of 5% over corresponding period in 2018 and also increased by 1% over the previous quarter.


Copra exports (refer to tables 6.2, 6.3 and 6.4)

- In June quarter 2019, the quantity of copra exports increased by 41% or 672 tonnes over the June quarter 2019 and 1,970 tonnes from 354 tonnes in the previous quarter.
- In value terms, copra exports decreased by 44% or VT 65 million over June quarter 2018 and VT 61 million over the previous quarter.
- Copra export receipts constituted a 7% share of the total domestic exports in value for June quarter 2019.
- The average export price of copra on year to year quarter fell by 60% and 39% over the previous quarter.

Coconut Oil (refer to Tables 6.2, 6.3 and 6.4)


- The quantity of Coconut oil exports for June quarter 2019 fell by 37% or 401 tonnes over June quarter of 2018. However, it increased by 3% or 21 tonnes over the previous quarter.
- In Value terms, coconut oil exports decreased by 39% or VT 45 million in June quarter 2019 over June quarter 2018. However, it increased by 18% or VT 11 million compared to the March quarter 2019.

- The average export price of coconut oil decreased by 3% in the June quarter 2019 over the same quarter of the previous year and increased by 15% over March quarter of 2019.
- Coconut oil receipts constituted a 6% share of total domestic export value in June quarter 2019.

June quarter 2017 to June quarter 2019




Cocoa Exports (refer to Tables 6.2, 6.3 and 6.4)

- In June quarter 2019, the quantity of cocoa exports increased by 30% or 90 tonnes over the June quarter of 2018. Compared to March quarter of 2019, it also recorded an increase of 219 tons .
- In value terms, cocoa exports increased by 19% or VT 10 million over the same quarter of 2018.
- Cocoa exports receipts constituted a 5% share of the total domestic exports value in June quarter 2019.

June quarter 2017 to June quarter 2019




Beef (refer to Tables 6.2, 6.3 and 6.4)

- Beef exports decreased by 53% or 16 tonnes in June quarter 2019 over June quarter 2018 and also decreased by 49% or 13 tonnes over the previous month.
- In value terms, beef exports recorded decreases of 46% and 45% over the quarters of June and March 2019 respectively.
- The average beef export price increased by 16% over the June quarter 2018 and 9% compared to the previous quarter.
- Beef export value constituted a 1% share of the total domestic export receipts in June quarter 2019.

Kava (refer to Tables 6.2, 6.3and 6.4)

- Kava exports in quantity decreased by 19% or 52 tonnes in June quarter of 2019 over June quarter 2018. However, it recorded an increase of 9% or 19 tonnes over the previous quarter.


- In Value terms, kava exports stood at VT 758 million in June quarter 2019, representing an increase of 24% or VT 147 million over June quarter of 2018, also recorded an increase of 5% or VT 34 million compared to the previous quarter.

- Kava exports constituted a 60% share of the total domestic export receipts in June quarter 2019.
- The implied average kava export price increased by 53% over June quarter of 2018.

June quarter 2017 to June quarter 2019




Domestic Exports (refer to Tables 6.1, 6.2 and 6.5)

- In June quarter 2019, provisional figures, in domestic export (excluding re-exports) earnings increased by 4% or VT 53 million, mainly driven by the following export products; coconut meal at 51%, coffee at 29%, kava at 24%, cocoa at 19% and other products at 14% respectively over the June quarter of 2018.

- The exports by country of destination indicated that Other Countries registered the largest share of Vanuatu's main export with 49% or VT 615 million of total domestic exports in June quarter 2019, followed by Other MSG Countries at 24%, New Caledonia at 11%, Australia at 10%, New Zealand at 3%, European community at 2% and South Korea below 1% respectively. Other Countries top five were comprised of United States of America, Kiribati, China, Malaysia and Philippines.


Trade Deficit (refer to Table 6.1)

- Vanuatu's trade deficit stood at VT 7,176 million for June quarter 2019. It decreased by 7% or VT 556 million, thus showing a decrease in total imports by 12% over June quarter 2018.

Imports for Home Consumption (refer to Tables 6.6 and 6.8)

- Imports for home consumption decreased in value by 10% or VT 930 million from VT 9,359 million in June quarter 2018 to VT 8,430 million in June quarter of 2019.
- The imported commodity groups that contributed to this decrease were: Crude materials at (-61%), goods not classified elsewhere at (-25%), machines and transport at (-23%), oils and fats at (-18%), miscellaneous manufactured goods at (-13%), chemical products at (-10%), food and live animals at (-2%) and basic manufactured goods at (-1%).
- In contrast the rest of the imported items that increased include; Mineral fuels at 27%, and beverages and tobacco at 8% over June quarter 2018

- In terms of share of commodity groups to total imports receipts, machines and transport made up the largest value (C.I.F) of VT 2,246 million or 27% of the total imports for home consumption, followed by food and live animals at 21%, mineral fuels at 15%, basic manufactured products at 14%, miscellaneous manufactured goods at 8%, chemical products at 7%, beverages and tobacco at 4%, crude materials at 2%, and goods not classified elsewhere at 1% and oils, fats and waxes at less than 1% of the total imports for home consumption.

- The total value of the selected ten major imported items increased by 15% or VT 236 million from VT 1,612 million in corresponding quarter of 2018 to VT 1,848 million in June quarter 2019.


- The commodities that increased were: Jet fuel at 58%, motor spirit at 54%, wheat flour at 52%, pharmaceutical products at 43%, and distillate fuels at 16% respectively, except for imported commodities which decreased: cement at (-31%), cigarettes and tobacco (-23%) and rice at (-21%) of the total value of the selected ten major imported items over the June quarter of 2018.

- In terms of the share of the selected ten major imports receipts; Distillate fuels recorded the largest share at 39%, followed by jet fuel at 14%, rice at 11%, wheat flour and pharmaceutical products at 9% each, motor spirit at 8%, cement cigarettes and tobacco at 5% each., while the rest of the commodities recorded less than 1%.

June quarter 2016 to June quarter 2018




Tourism (refer to Tables 7.1 to 7.4)

- The provisional total international visitor arrivals to Vanuatu for June quarter 2019 stood at 53,168. This is a decline of 36% over corresponding period in 2018 and also 10% over the previous quarter. The decline of visitor arrivals over corresponding period were attributed by the fall in number of visitor arrivals by both air and sea.

- The seasonally adjusted visitor arrivals represent a fall for day visitors but an increase for visitors by air in June quarter 2019.
- Visitors by air made up 53% of all international visitors to Vanuatu. This stood at 28,413, indicating a slight decline of 1% over corresponding quarter in 2018 but increased by 27% over March quarter 2019.
- Australian visitors represented 52% of all air visitors in June quarter 2019.
- Countries that recorded an increase over corresponding quarter of 2018 include; Europe at 33%; China at 11% and other pacific countries at 1%.
- Holiday visitors accounted for 78% of air visitors; followed by visiting friends and relatives at 8%, business, meetings or conferences and other purposes at 7% each while visitors on transit at less than 1%.
- Day visitors made up 47% of all international visitors to Vanuatu. Total day visitors stood at 24,755, a fall of 54% over June quarter 2018 and also fell by 32% over March quarter 2018. The decline over corresponding quarter was attributed by a drop in cruise ship visits.

June quarter 2017 to June quarter 2019




Consumer Price Index (refer to Tables 4.1 and 4.2)

- The Consumer Price Index (CPI) of June quarter 2019 indicated an increase of (+0.7%). Port Vila slightly increased by (+0.7%) and Luganville by (+0.1%) compared to the previous quarter . When compared to the June quarter of 2018, the Vanuatu index increased by (+2.3%), Port Vila index increased by (+2.7%) while Luganville index slightly increased by (+0.6%).

At the national level, the expenditure groups that contributed to the increase over the same quarter of last year were: Food (+4.6%), Transport (+1.8%), Miscellaneous (+1.7%), Recreation (+1.3%), Alcoholic drinks and Tobacco, Clothing and footwear and communication at (+0.5%) each, Household supplies and education at (+0.4%) each and Housing and utilities at (+0.3%) . The increase in these expenditure groups were driven by the increase in price movements of Root crops, Fruits and Vegetables, Automatic Fuel and oil, Toiletries and other personal care products, Sports Membership fees, Packet cigarettes, Island dress, Mobile phones, Furniture and Furnishes, School fees and Electricity supply charges.

Summary of Government Revenue and Expenditure


Total Government Operation (TGO) (refer to Table 5.1)*

- The total government revenue for June quarter 2019 stood at VT 9,777.8 million of which 77% is recurrent revenue while 23% were grants received from abroad. Total revenue increased by 5% over corresponding period in 2018 but fell by 6% over previous quarter.
- The total government expenditure for June quarter increased by 11% over corresponding period in 2018 but fell by 6% over March quarter 2019.


Government Revenue (refer to Table 5.1)

- The total government revenue excluding donors in June quarter 2019 stood at VT 7,517.1 million, this is an increase of 5.2% over corresponding period in 2018, but fell by 7% over previous quarter. The total tax revenue collected for June quarter totalled VT 4,148.7 million, this fell by 2% over June quarter 2018 and also fell by 16% over the previous quarter.


Government Expenditure (refer to Table 5.1)

- The total government expenditure in June quarter 2019 totalled VT 6,696 million.
- Compensation of employees made up 53% or VT 3,559.9 million of total government expenditure in June quarter 2019. This is an increase of 7% compared to June quarter in 2018 and also an increase of 23% over the previous quarter.

Energy Consumption (refer to Table 3)


- The total energy consumed (expressed in Kilowatts) for June quarter 2019 stood at 19,300. This increased by 15% over corresponding period in 2018 but fell by 9% over previous quarter. The increase was attributed by the increase in electricity consumption for Tanna at 36%, Malekula at 28%, Port Vila at 14% and Luganville at 13%.

June quarter 2017 to June quarter 2019




- The total volume of imported petrol, diesel and kerosene stood at 14,636 litres in the June quarter of 2019, showing a decrease of 38% over the same quarter of 2018 and 20% over the previous quarter.

- The total number of new private motor vehicle registrations in Luganville stood at 82. This is an increase of 5% in vehicle registrations in Luganville over previous quarter.
